THE BEGINNING OF THE END OF ABORTION

40 Days for Life is a worldwide simultaneous prayer vigil that takes place near local abortion centres and other appropriate places with the intention of saving lives and bringing about the end of abortion through prayerful, peaceful witness.



With easy-access chemical abortion now widespread your prayers and witness are needed more than ever before!



HOW IT WORKS

The 40 Days for Life vigil in 2026 is
Wednesday 18 February to Sunday 29 March
Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
7am to 12pm

Each hour of peaceful vigil near the abortion centre must be covered by at least two prayer volunteers signing up for a specific time.

Registering the hour(s) you intend to be present is essential as it lets the Vigil Co-ordinator know if enough people will be present throughout the day.

You are not expected to be at the vigil site alone.

40 Days for Life is a prayer vigil, not a protest.

ENGAGING WITH THE PUBLIC

You do not have to speak with the public, however, you should be courteous and friendly to those who approach.

Be a peaceful, polite and kind presence on the street. Do smile and say hello to the public, most especially if they make eye contact with you. You will leave a lasting impression.

If a member of the public genuinely wants to chat, it is ideal to have one person from the group move off to the side with them and listen to what they have to say. This allows the rest of the group to continue in prayer while honouring the person who wants to speak.

Resources and handouts are available at the street vigil for you to take with you or to hand out to the public.

Prayer and fasting for an end to abortion and for all those involved and impacted - babies, mothers, fathers, workers, etc.

Peaceful vigil outside or near a local abortion centre.

Community outreach through a visible presence and providing information about foetal development, abortion, life-affirming alternatives, and after-abortion healing programmes.
